Whitley Bay High school is situated in the North East of England on the coast, near to the large vibrant town of Newcastle upon Tyne. It is a large secondary school catering for 1613 students of which 556 are in the sixth form. The students follow a broad balanced curriculum and a high percentage of students go on to study at University.

The school promotes a collaborative approach to learning for students and staff and through a well oragnised and highly regarded training programme develops and trials new teaching techniques and adapts current educational research for use in the classroom. Following a recent Ofsted inspection the school was judged to be "outstanding".






Q1 Sometimes our teachers teach a lesson together

Q2 Special achievements of a student are sometimes rewarded in front of all the other students (e.g. at an assembly).




Pupils are recognised and rewarded and this is clearly understood by the students.



Q3 I like our school building and our school environment very much.



Q4 Older students get involved with younger students, for example as classroom support





Q5 The student council of our school is very active.




We operate a student forum and council meeting every half term which is attended by representatives from each year group. This is a disappointing result and one for immediate action.






Q15 The teacher makes it clear to us what we should have mastered by the end of the lesson.



Q16 I constantly get tips how to learn from my mistakes.







Q17 The teacher sets the students different tasks according to their level of knowledge.

Differentiation is a key focus in successful teaching and learning. Therefore for lessons not to cater for individual needs is concerning. An item for staff training possibly?


Q18 The teacher encourages me to reflect about myself and my behaviour.




Q19 We regularly use the computer during lessons and for homework.




Q20 The teacher regularly checks our homework





Observations from the parents' questionnaire:

The results show an over whelming satisfaction with the care and education that parents feel their children receive.

There are 2 areas that need further discussion – information that the school produces and the mechanisms in place to keep parents informed is an area in which improvements can be made. And secondly any concerns that are raised need to be more promptly dealt with. Systems need to be put in place to ensure a holding email / telephone call is made to ensure a swift response.
